Dear Parents,

It is difficult to believe that we are a week into October, with only two weeks to go until half term already! It feels like only yesterday that the teachers were preparing for their new classes and the Reception children were getting ready for their first day. A big well done to all of the children for how they have settled in this term. It was particularly lovely to see so many of them speaking so confidently in front of everybody at the Harvest Church service last week.

Parent Thanks: I have often said that we are so fortunate at Debden to have so many parents and community members who help our school to thrive. However, in recent weeks, they have surpassed themselves. I would like to say a huge thank you to our FODS for purchasing ten new iPads for the school! We are so grateful – as these will prove to be vital learning and research resources for years to come. We now have enough iPads to enable children in even the biggest classes to use one iPad, which will significantly enhance their independent learning time. I would also like to express our thanks to a number our parents (particularly Mrs Samson/the FODs, Mr Bolding and Mrs Wilson) for the work that they have done in furnishing and organising our school library. It is looking better than it has in years! Thanks also to the families who have donated books to our library.

Thank you to Mr Rose, who has been into the school a few times to fix different parts of our outdoor trim trail equipment (saving the school a sizeable repair bill). Finally, a big thank you to Mr and Mrs Platt –parents of two former Debden children now in secondary school – who have purchased some new football goals that will be erected in the next few weeks. What a lucky school we are to have received all of this support!

<u>Harvest</u>: Thank you to everyone for bringing in food items in advance of the Harvest Service. Rev'd John arranged for the food to be collected from the school this week. It has made its way to the food bank, where it will be allocated towards those who are less fortunate around the local area.

<u>Hockey</u>

Thanks to all those year 4, 5 and 6 children who turned up to JFAN in the rain for hockey last Friday – we hope you all enjoyed the impromptu indoor training experience! Apologies for the mix up about timings, which meant we missed our slot with our student coach, Josh. We have now confirmed that hockey training this term will take place at the earlier time of 3.45pm to 4.45pm - and we can always make room for a few more players if the change of time now means your child can attend.

By way of a reminder, no previous experience is necessary and it's a fun opportunity for the children to get outdoors and be part of a friendly and enthusiastic team. All the children need to play is a gum shield, shin pads (available from Amazon or Saffron Sports) - and a willingness to give it a go! A hockey stick can be provided.

This term's training and next term's matches all take place on the pitches at the back of Joyce Frankland Academy from 3.45pm. No other travel is involved and lifts can potentially be provided by other parents/carers.
