Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Summer Term. I hope that you have all enjoyed the Easter holidays and had a well-deserved break. I am looking forward to welcoming all the children back into the classroom to embrace another term of learning!

This term our Topic will be ***The Romans!*** This topic provides lots of opportunities to enjoy fun enrichment activities throughout the term. We will be learning about the daily life of the Romans; including examining the differences in architecture, food, clothing, religion and social structure. We will also examine the success of their army and how they built such a powerful empire.

We will continue to block some of our foundation subjects; for example, history, geography, DT and music. This enables us to cover each unit in more depth and has proved to produce a much higher level of work from the children. On the next page, you will find the outline of learning across the subjects that will be taught his half term. The Knowledge Organisers give further information about the content and expectations of each unit/topic. We use these a lot in class to revise each subject's content but please do discuss these with the children at home and reinforce learning. We have also planned some trips in different curriculum areas to supplement our learning.

***PE continues to be on a Monday and Wednesday- please ensure that your child comes into school in PE kit on these days.*** Please also ensure that all school uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name. At the end of each day, we have a collection of uniform that is not labelled and it is very difficult to return these, leading to an accumulation in the classroom.

The homework grid contains a variety of tasks based on our current topic. This is optional and children can complete as many tasks as they wish from any section. Each child should have their own homework book to complete the tasks in- please see me if you need a new one. We will share, celebrate and give feedback to children on the week **commencing 20<sup>th</sup> May.**

Please continue to fill out the homework planners. As a reminder, children should be reading 4 times a week, practising their spellings and times tables on TT Rockstars. These children will receive extra break time on Friday and move their name up the learning behaviour ladder. The planners must be signed by a parent/carer each week to confirm this has been completed.
