# FROGS' ROMANS FACTS and INFORMATION

## ROMAN ENTERTAINMENT

The Romans loved entertainment. There was no electricity it was long before the cinema and tv. They enjoyed watching plays, live music, singing, poetry, sport and board games. Archaeologists have even found counters from a board game. Vespasian ruled the Roman Empire from 69 AD-79 AD. During this time he ordered an amphitheatre to be built called the Colosseum.



### Gladiators

Gladiators were men who were used for entertainment. Lot of people would gather to watch gladiators fight. They often fought until one of them died.

# Roman Entertainment

## Chariot Racing

Chariot Racing was one of the most favorite sports that time. It was also very dangerous but the Romans thought it was fun. The slaves built a building called the Circus maximus. It could hold 25000 people. The chariots were pulled by horses. There were also four teams blue & green red and white. Many of the chariots were flung over and some times dragged to death.



## Gladiator fighting

Gladiators are men who were used to fight other people and slaves. The gladiators also used to fight animals such as lions, hippos, crocodiles, elephants, leopards, bears, tigers and bears. If both gladiator stay alive the audience would choose who should live and who should die. The Romans also loved watching battles and fighting to be a gladiator you had to be strong. The Romans loved blood and death.



## The Roman bath

Going to the baths is something else that the Romans did in their spare time. There are still baths left Roman times in England. They went to the baths to get clean. Whilst at the baths the Romans also exercise and swim. There are some rooms in the bath with their temperature very, very high. This was designed to help the Romans sweat out dirt.



Other entertainment the Romans didn't have electric so most of the Romans like watching plays, live music concerts, singing poetry recital, sport and board games. The Romans also hunted animals for fun. It got so good that they would bring deers to Britain just so they could kill them. Vespasian built the Colosseum for the people because King Nero was very, very mean to the people. It was designed to make entertainment for his people. The people also did long jumps and women were allowed to use weights.

## Ancient Rome Entertainment

### Chariot Racing:

Rome's race track, called the Circus Maximus, could hold a crowd of 250,000 people! Riders charged around seven laps of the stadium in chariots either pulled by two horses or four horses. There were four teams: blues, greens, red and white.



### Baths:

Going to the Baths is something else that Romans did in their spare time. There are still some baths left from Roman times in England. They are in a place called... Bath! They went to the Baths to get clean! Whilst at the Baths, Romans would do some exercises and some swimming.

### Gladiator Fighting:

Vespasian ruled the Roman Empire from AD 69-79. During this time, he ordered a huge amphitheatre to be built which was called the Colosseum.

In AD 68, an unpopular emperor called Nero died. The amphitheatre was a symbol of joy to the Roman people, who had all suffered under Nero's rule. The amphitheatre was completed in AD 80.



### Hunting:

Romans also hunted animals in their spare time. They didn't just kill animals for food; they killed them for fun too. They liked hunting deer.

They enjoyed watching plays, live music concerts (using Roman instruments - different from today's instruments).

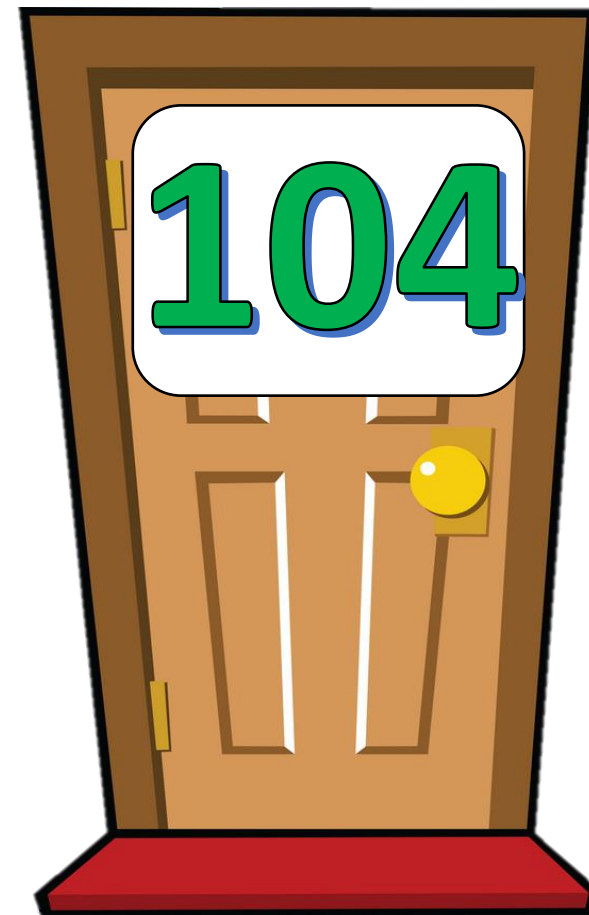
