Design and make a typical Anglo-Saxon house. Be creative in the way you make this.	Write a poem based on an Anglo-Saxon god
Write 5 questions that you would like to ask an Anglo-Saxon.	Make an Anglo-Saxon broach.	Produce an information leaflet about Sutton Hoo or West Stow.	Find an Anglo-Saxon recipe, e.g. honey shortbread and make it.
Write a story based in the Anglo-Saxon times.	Create a timeline of important events in Anglo-Saxon Britain. Be creative in the way you make this.	Design your own Anglo-Saxon coin or shield.	Use a map to find out places in Britain that have Anglo-Saxon names. Create a glossary of what these names mean. E.g., Oxford = ford (shallow part of river) ox (where oxen can cross).
Create a newspaper report about an Anglo-Saxon invasion.	Create an Anglo-Saxon recipe using ingredients that would have been available at this time.
