



If not addressed early the educational gap widens...





Standardised Test Scores

(and get paid more, on average).



Research shows that...

*“Children who choose to **read** books for pleasure outside of school are more likely to secure managerial or professional jobs in later life.”*

(Demos, 2018).

It has more of an impact than:

- Where a child comes from;
- What their parent does for a job.

Research shows that...

*“Children who **read** show more empathy for others – they have a heightened ability to understand the feelings and beliefs of others.”*

(Kidd, 2013).

They also report:

- Having more close relationships;
- Have more people that they consider as friends.



FACT 5

**THERE IS EVEN EVIDENCE
THAT PEOPLE WHO READ AS
CHILDREN LIVE LONGER, ,
HEALTHIER, LIVES! (on average)**



Research shows that...

*“People who **read** books for 30 minutes a day live, on average nearly two-years longer than non-readers.”*

(Yale University, 2014).

It is thought to be because:

- Knowledge about health;
- Less stressed – happier with work and social life;
- More affluent: ability to make healthy choices;



Chocolate bar #2: Yummy Crunch Fairy


