The Ancient Egyptian pharaoh Cleopatra was an incredible female pharaoh, but she wasn't the first. Hatsheput was also a female pharaoh, but Sobekneferu was the first ever female pharaoh. Sobekneferu wore mens clothes and a false beard because the pharaoh was supposed to be an Egyptian god on earth. The Egyptian god was a male, so Sobekneferu had to look like one.



Most of the pyramids in Egypt were protected by booby-traps. Even so, tomb raiders still managed to get in and steal prized possessions. Because of this, Ancient Egyptian pharaohs started having their tombs built into cliff faces or under ground.

All Egyptians believed in something called "The Afterlife." They believed that when you died, you went to the afterlife. They also believed that you have to go through a test before the gods let you in to the afterlife. The test was that the gods would weigh your heart. If your heart was heavier than a feather then they wouldn't let you in. They put the organs, like the intestines and the stomach, in sealed jars and buried in the tomb with the sarcophagus.

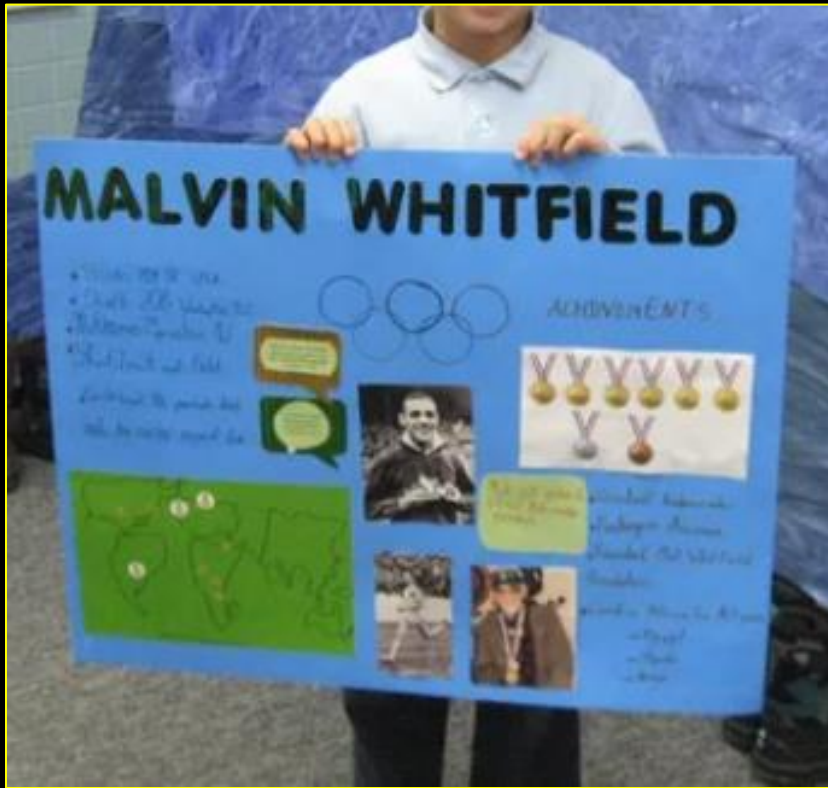
