Art: Draw or paint a self-portrait	History: Draw a family tree for the house of Tudor.	History/Computing: Research and create a fact file on William Shakespeare or Jacques Francis.	Art: Recreate a renaissance drawing or painting by Leonardo Da Vinci or Hans Holbein.
History: Make a quiz about the Tudors.	English: Write your own sonnet or playscript (you could perform it to the class if you wanted!)	DT: Bake some Tudor bread or make some medieval pottage stew.	History/Computing: - Create a presentation, fact file or scratch animation about the Spanish Armada.
History/Computing: Create a timeline of the life of a Tudor king or Queen or for the whole Tudor period.	History/English: Write a diary entry from the perspective of Henry VIII or one of his wives.	English/Drama: Perform a Shakespearean sonnet or part of a Shakespeare play (To friends, family or the class!) Maths: Create some percentage or ratio questions for a friend or family member to solve (make sure to work out the answer yourself to check they're right!)	English: Rewrite a modern version of a scene from Macbeth.	History/PSHE: Explain: Which of Henry VIII's wives do you think was the most unfortunate? Why?
History/Art: The Tudor Rose is a symbol of the Tudor family. Roses and the colours used all have a meaning. Create your own emblem that could be used for your family and explain why you have chosen the colours and symbols that you have.	Art/History: Create a poster advertising for Henry VIII's next wife.
