History/English: Investigate the different types of aeroplane Amelia Earhart flew. How do they differ from today?	English: Write a fact file about a famous explorer of your choice.	Drama: Through improvisation, role play and movement, act out a poem.	Art: Using inspiration from Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram, design your own space scene with Aliens. You can use pastels, pencils, paint etc.
English/Art: Create your own visual poem using one of the explorers as inspiration.	Art/DT: Design your own rocket ship to get to the moon.	DT/English: recipe instructions Bake rock cakes and write your own instructions. Don't forget to take pictures of the end result! English: Write a recount of your imaginative trip to the moon.	Maths: Make a timeline of the key events/achievements from one of the key explorers.	Geography: Draw and label a map of North and South America. Which modes of transport would you use to get from one side of America to the other and which countries would you pass over/through?	DT/Art: Choose either a UK mountain or Mount Everest, and design/make it using a your choice of materials.
Maths: Find out how many weeks it took Christopher Columbus to find the New World. How many days did it take in total?	RE: How do you think religion differed in 1492 when Christopher Columbus found the New World? Do you think it was any different to today?	Maths: Re-read Man on the Moon. How long was Bob at work for?
