History: Recreate an Anglo-Saxon battle, through role play, drawings or with toys.	English/PSHE: How would you be feeling if you were Zoe in 'Floodlands'? Would you do anything differently to her?	Science/Art: Create a poster or leaflet about evolution and inheritance.	Art: Draw a picture of a moment from Beowulf.
English: Write a dystopian story.	Art/DT: Make an Anglo-Saxon helmet, weapon, or jewellery.	History: How was life during the Anglo-Saxon times similar or different to life now?	DT: Bake Anglo-Saxon honey oat cakes or write a recipe for them.
English: Write a diary entry from an Anglo-Saxon.	Science: Explain natural selection through writing, pictures or a video.	English: Write some sentences about the Anglo-Saxons in active and passive voice.	English/ICT: Research and write facts or a biography about Charles Darwin or Alfred Wallace.
