Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Dragonflies Class and Year 2! I hope you have all had a wonderful and restful summer. We are excited to welcome the children back and embrace a new year of learning; we have lots of exciting things planned to engage and enhance the curriculum.

Mrs Auty will lead the class on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesday mornings; followed by Miss Douglas on Wednesdays after break, and Thursdays and Fridays. PE lessons this term will be on a Wednesday and Friday afternoon (please come into school wearing PE kit).

This term our topic will be Famous For More than 5 Minutes, looking at some incredible adventurers and explorers including Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong, Edmund Hilary and Tenzing Norgay. We will also explore the amazing artists Vincent van Gough and Romare Bearden.

The children will be expected to read daily at home, and have all been provided with a new reading folder and reading record to track this. They currently have two books to take home with them to practice their reading skills, which will be changed regularly once they have shown both fluency and comprehension for the text.

Spellings will be given out on a Friday for the children to take home and practice at home over the week, with a spelling test the following Friday morning in class. They will have time to practice their spellings in class, but please ensure they spend some time learning them at home as well.

Homework grids will also be sent home in a homework book, which include a variety of tasks based on learning covered this half term. Children can either choose one task every couple of weeks, or spend longer completing a bigger task. Homework is not compulsory but there will be rewards for those children who do engage in them. The children will be given a homework book to complete the tasks, in which they bring in and share with the class. We will share, celebrate and give feedback to children on Monday 21st October and Wednesday 23rd October. Please bring in your homework on these dates.

We look forward to working alongside all the families in Dragonflies Class this year, helping the children to achieve an engaging and successful first term in Year 2!
