

# J.K ROWLING

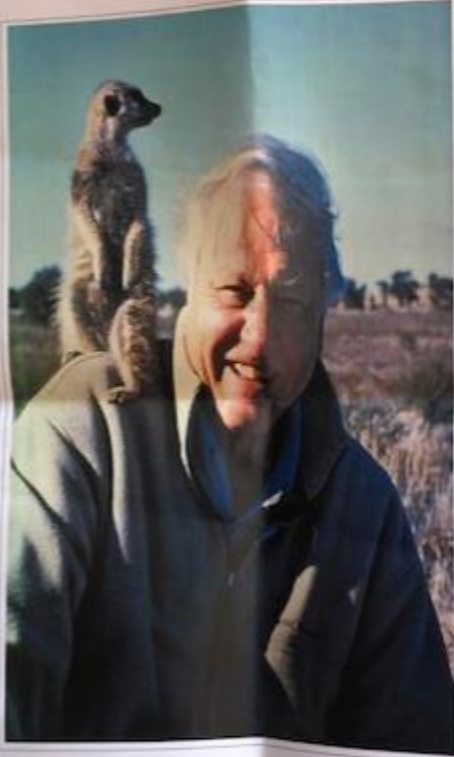
# JAMES C

## SIR DAVID ATTENBOROUGH

Sir David Attenborough is a naturalist who, from when he was a boy, was fascinated by the wonders of nature. Over the last few years he has been alerting us to climate change and how it is destroying our world.

### As a Boy

As a boy David Attenborough was very interested in nature. He was born in Isleworth, Middlesex and spent his childhood collecting fossils, stones, and natural specimens. He received encouragement aged seven, when a young Jaquetta Hawkes (an archeologist) admired his "museum" David Attenborough is the middle of three sons; his elder brother Richard and his younger brother, John.



### Achievements

David Attenborough is well known for the nine-part Life series which started his career. He writes books, is a former BBC senior manager and makes wild life documentaries. Attenborough was knighted in 1985 and has been a sir for 36 years and is one of the 100 greatest Britons of all time. Beginning with Life On Earth in 1979, Attenborough started creating many documentaries which set the standard in wildlife film-making and influenced many of film-makers. Blue Planet 2 was broadcast in 2017, with Attenborough returning as presenter.

### Environmental work

David Attenborough's programmes have often talked about how people are destroying the planet. In 2005 and 2006, he supported a project to stop the killing of albatross by longline fishing boats and he gave public support to WWF's campaign to have 220,000 square kilometers of Borneo's rainforest a protected area.

In 2010, Errrol's life changed forever when he was diagnosed with prostate cancer and nearly died. He now has the all clear after radiotherapy.

Prostate cancer is the most common cancer in men. (1 in 8 men)

He is an ambassador for Prostate Cancer UK and set up his own foundation. The Errrol Mackellar Foundation recently launched.

The men's health foundation will give presentations and talks around the UK.

Their campaign MOT Yourself inspires men to get checked.

Errrol is my neighbour and he inspires me because he got an MBE from the Queen and he helps save lives.
