<p>Science: Research Charles Darwin or Alfred Wallace and write facts or a biography about them.</p>	<p>English/PSHE: Draw and explain what 6 things you would want to take with you if you were evacuated and why. How would you feel?</p>	<p>Maths/Science: Find out what the Enigma machine did and where it was based.</p>	<p>Art: Make a drawing, painting, or collage of a Second World War scene.</p>
<p>English: Write instructions or an advice leaflet for citizens to follow during the Blitz to stay safe.</p>	<p>Art/DT: Make a Second World War artefact e.g. medal, ration book, gas mask, model plane etc.</p>	<p>English/Computing/Art: Research the different jobs during WWII and design a poster or advert persuading people to become either a soldier, a billeting officer, a nurse, factory worker or a member of the home guard.</p>	<p>DT: Bake or cook a wartime recipe. How may these advances have impacted the severity of WW2?</p>	<p>History/English: Imagine you are a journalist. Write a newspaper report about a significant event during the Second World War</p>	<p>History/Computing: Research and write facts or a biography about a significant individual in the Second World War e.g Anne Frank, Winston Churchill, Franklin Roosevelt, Alan Turing, Adolf Hitler etc.</p>
