History: Make a timeline of Victorian inventions or key events during the Victorian period, including dates.	English: Write your own version of A Christmas Carol or Oliver Twist. Be creative!	English: Create either a crossword or word search using your spellings (remember to spell them correctly!). You could get a friend to have a go at it!	History: Research and make a fact file about one or more of these prominent Victorians: Queen Victoria, Charles Darwin (scientist), Lewis Carroll (author), Charles Dickens (author), Elizabeth Garrett Anderson (First female doctor), or Alexander Graham Bell (Inventor).
English: Write a story or diary entry set in or about someone's life in a Victorian workhouse.	Art/DT: Draw or make a model of a building designed by Norman Foster or Zaha Hadid.	History: Find out about life for children who worked as chimney sweeps or trappers in coal mines.	<b>PSHE/English:</b> Write a SATs guide advising someone of the best ways to prepare for them and handle any nerves.
English: Write an advertisement for a Victorian invention to sell it to the public. Be persuasive and convince people that they should buy it!	DT: Cook or bake a Victorian recipe!	Science: Draw and label the lifecycle of a plant or humans.	Art/DT: Sketch and label a Victorian invention or make a model version.
