



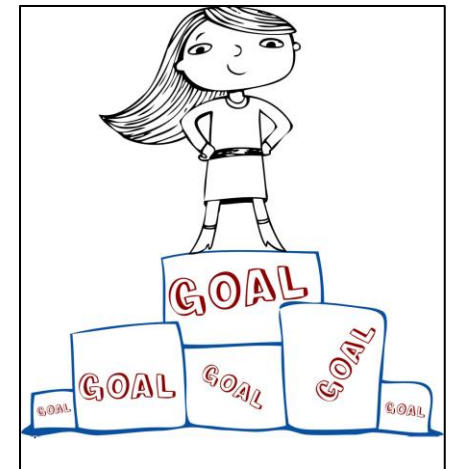
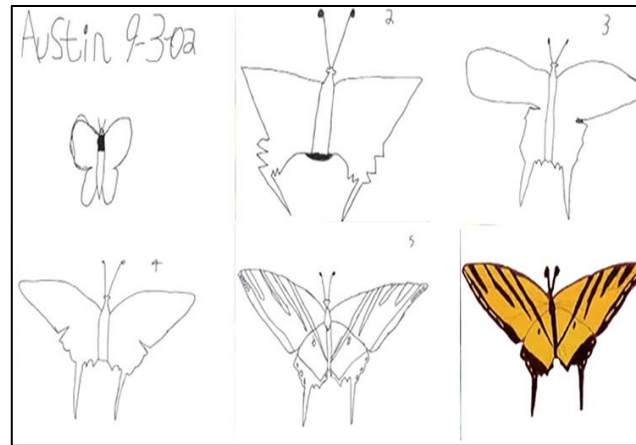


WELL DONE LUCY!

 - Goes out of their way to help someone else.



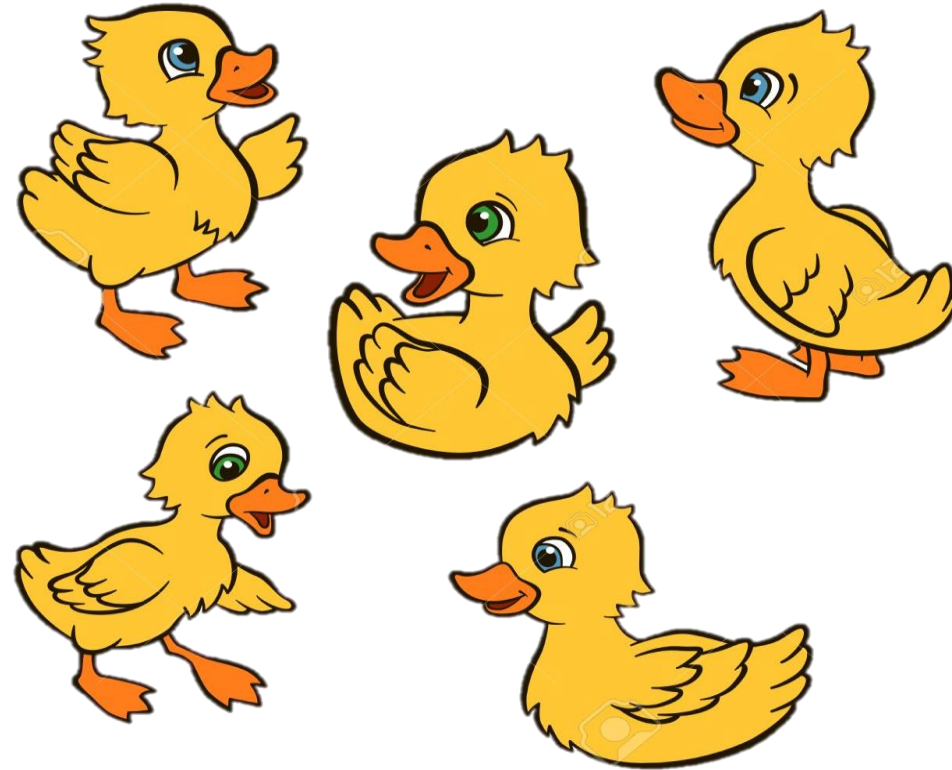
