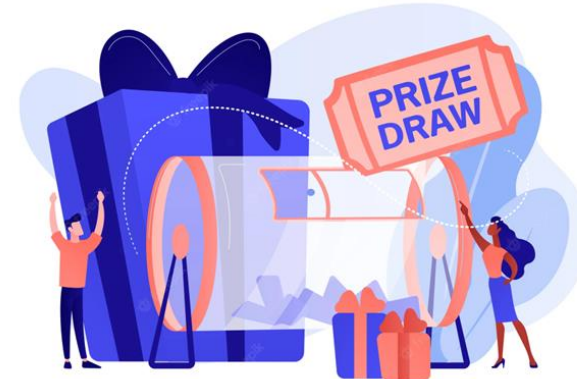

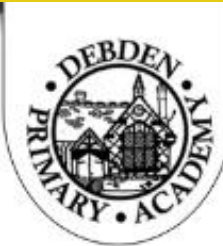


BEHAVIOUR HERO OF THE WEEK!
