<b>Science:</b> Research Michael Faraday, Nikola Tesla, Thomas Edison or Joseph Swan.	<b>English (Creative Writing):</b> Write a story set in Roman times.	<b>History:</b> Find the Greek and Roman equivalent gods e.g Zeus (Greek) and Jupiter (Roman) are the same.	<b>Art:</b> Make a drawing or painting inspired by Roman art or architecture.
<b>DT:</b> Make a shield, sword or armour that a Roman soldier would have.	<b>English/Drama:</b> Write a playscript. You could perform it to the class.	<b>Maths:</b> Make maths word problems related to the Romans. Try them out on a friend or family member and see if they get them right!	<b>DT:</b> Create a model of the Colosseum or of a Roman town. Label it with the different features.
<b>English:</b> Write a poem that has something to do with the Romans. Can you make it rhyme?	<b>Drama/English:</b> Write a description of or short story about your character in the play. You could draw a picture alongside.	<b>English/Drama:</b> Learn your lines and the songs! You could rehearse with your friends or get your family to help.	<b>History/Computing:</b> Research Pompeii or Herculaneum. Create a fact file or presentation about it.
<b>History:</b> Create a quiz to test the class about the Romans. Remember to have the answers!	<b>Computing/History:</b> Research the Roman invasion of Britain.	<b>History:</b> Make a timeline of key events during the Roman period.	<b>Art/DT:</b> Draw or make Mount Vesuvius.
<b>History/Computing:</b> Research and make a fact file about one or more of the following famous Roman emperors or leaders. Leaders in the Republic: Julius Caesar, Mark Anthony, Scipio Africanus, Marcus Tullius Cicero. Emperors: Augustus Caesar, Nero, Tiberius, Caligula, Septimus Severus.	<b>History:</b> How do the Romans spread over time? What lands do they conquer? Colour Roman territory on a map or make a timeline of places they conquered.	<b>Art:</b> Draw (or make) a small mosaic tile, including a typically Roman pattern or design. You could paint it, make it out of clay or do it as a collage.	<b>Free Choice:</b> Choose your own project related to the Romans or another topic we've studied this half-term. Surprise me with your creativity!
