'Intentional' - It is done on purpose (not by accident).

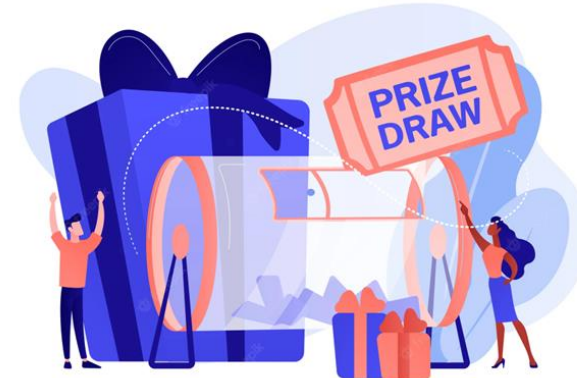
The person or group may think they are better, stronger, smarter than the other person.

 - Goes out of their way to help someone else.



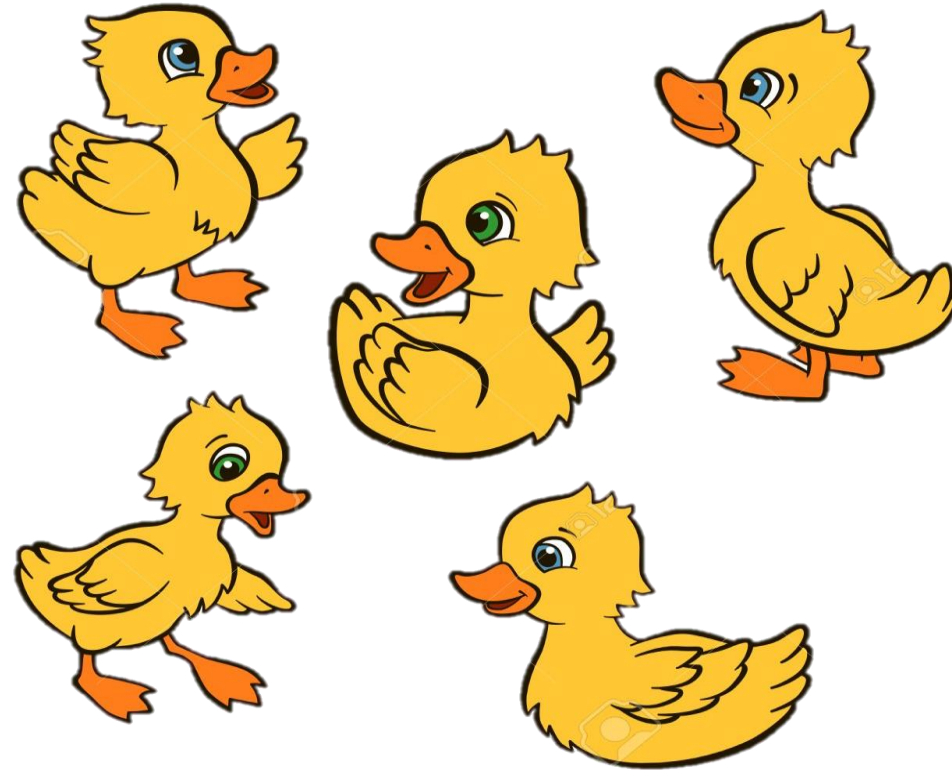
