These will include details of your child's progress and attainment in each subject (exact scores will also be given for KS1 and KS2 SATs, Year 1 Phonics Check and Year 4 Multiplication Check), an outline of their learning behaviours, skills and their attendance, written comments from the teachers and myself and targets for the year ahead. A confirmation to all year 6 parents – we have received the KS2 SATs results and these will be included in the reports. The reports will be sent to you by Monday 18th July.

YUVA Trip: The FODs have been very busy recently, as besides the DebFest, they also treated our Year 6 children to a meal at the YUVA restaurant last week! This was a lovely gesture that was appreciated by all – even those year 6s who ate too much and struggled through the afternoon!
